

# Mark Burleigh Gradberg

August 25, 1950 - March 29, 2018

Mark Burleigh Gradberg, 67, of Kankakee passed away on Thursday, March 29, 2018 at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee. He was born on August 25, 1950 in Harvey, the son of Evan and Eileen (Snyder) Gradberg. Mark married Kathleen Lindsay on October 20, 1973 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Bradley.

Mark's parents led him to know Jesus Christ and have a relationship with the Savior. Because of his Christian upbringing, he cultivated a faith-based lifestyle that influenced his family and community, and ensured his place in eternity.

Mark was a 1968 graduate of Kankakee Eastridge High School, and he attended the very first hour of the first class ever held at Kankakee Community College. He received his Bachelor's Degree of Clinical Psychology from Illinois State University in 1974. Working in Psychology for a short time, as well as the EJ&E Railroad in Joliet, Mark then retired from the Dow Chemical Company in Channahon in 1999. After retirement, he was the entrepreneur of Gray Mountain Pipes where he crafted freehand and Danish-modern smoking pipes. This venture included attending national pipe and tobacco shows and selling his pipes world-wide.

He was an active member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Kankakee since 1985. He was the former Head Trustee, usher, member of the Joseph Ministry and the handbell choir, and part of the Brass ensemble.

As a skilled musician, he played trumpet with different groups including the Joliet School System, Joliet Legion Band, New Horizons Band, Kankakee Municipal Band, and the Brass Ensemble for special services at church.

In addition to playing trumpet, Mark was an avid scale model builder of HO scale trains and WWII military aircraft and also a British Sports Car enthusiast.

Mark was a licensed scuba diver, and he also enjoyed golfing, fishing, and classical music. A lover of sweets, he was known for his prize winning peanut butter fudge. Mark was a diehard fan of Chicago Cubs and Chicago Bears.

He is survived by his wife Kathleen Gradberg of Kankakee; three sons Eric (Kimberly) Gradberg of Woodridge, Aaron (Sonia) Gradberg of Chenoa and Matthew (Shawna) Gradberg of Frankfort; one daughter Krista (Nick) Rawlinson of Bossier City, LA; one sister Janeane Stewart of Lonoke, AR; and five grandchildren Carmen, Maya, Eva, Elliana and

Tyler Gradberg.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one brother Thomas Gradberg and one granddaughter Alexandra Gradberg.

Visitation will be held on Tuesday, April 3, 2018 from 4-8pm at Schreffler Funeral Home in Kankakee. Funeral service will be on Wednesday, April 4, 2018 at 10am at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Kankakee, with additional visitation starting one-hour prior. The Rev. Karl Koeppen will officiate.
