August 30, 1920 - May 14, 2015

August "Gus" D. Lambert, 94, of Bradley passed away on Thursday, May 14, 2015 at Presence Heritage Village in Kankakee. He was born on August 30, 1920 to Paul and Ida Curby Lambert on the family farm in Beaverville. Gus married Verletta Lietz on February 19, 1943.

Gus served in the United States Army from 1941-1945 and was awarded the high honor of the Purple Heart. He worked on the family farm until sustaining an injury in his leg during the war. After coming home from the service, he worked for Sears at the Roper Plant in Bradley. He purchased a hardware store in St. Anne in 1960. Gus was a member of the Bradley VFW.

He survived by his wife, Verletta Lambert of Bradley; one daughter Kathleen Quigley of Bradley; two sisters Vivian Langevin of Kankakee and Sister Myra Lambert of Batavia; three brothers Leonard Lambert of Bradley, Francis Lambert of Beaverville and Paul Lambert, Jr. of Texas; and many grandchildren and great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, five brothers Vern, Calvin, Don, Roy and Leland and two sisters Pauline Arseneau and Doreen Lambert.

The funeral service will be held on Tuesday, May 19, 2015 at 1:00 p.m. at Schreffler Funeral Home in Bourbonnais with a visitation period one hour prior to the service.
