Betty L. Decker R.N., age 83, formerly of Kankakee passed away Monday, June 28, 2021 at her home in Manteno. She was born June 3, 1938 in Kankakee, the daughter of Lester & Eileen (Boudreau) Billings.

Betty is a graduate of St Joseph's School of Nursing in Joliet and worked as a Registered Nurse for over 40 years. She began her nursing career at AMITA St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee where she worked for 3 years, before moving to Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee when it opened in 1964. She remained at Riverside for 30 years until she moved to Arizona. She retired from Scottsdale Memorial Hospital in Arizona in 2000. She enjoyed crocheting, doing crossword puzzles and jigsaw puzzles.

Betty was a longtime parishioner of St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Kankakee and most recently a parishioner of St. John Paul II Catholic Church.
