



Brenda Marie Richardson

August 2, 1962 - December 18, 2017

Brenda Richardson, 55, passed away on Sunday, December 18th, 2017, holding the hand of her husband and surrounded by the family to which she devoted her life.

You could usually find her in the kitchen, pot of coffee brewing, ready to offer a hug and “It will be alright, sweetheart” to anyone who came through the back door--which was never locked. The word that described her best was Mom: she had a special way with children and those who needed just a little extra help. Following in her own mother’s footsteps, she worked for nearly two decades guiding kids of all ages in her home daycare. For the past seventeen years she was very proud to work in the Bradley Elementary School system, providing her usual comfort, calm, and compassion as a paraprofessional for children with special needs.

Brenda was born on August 2, 1962 and lived her entire life in or near Bradley, Illinois. Her childhood was full of joy, laughter, and love as the oldest of the six Lamie children. She married Skip shortly after high school and their family blossomed. She was overjoyed to become a grandmother to Wesley last year. Brenda was happiest when surrounded by loved ones with nowhere to go, whether at a beach house, a girls camping trip, or in her own living room making a little one giggle. Seeing other people smile made her smile. Feeling other people’s happiness made her happy.

She is survived by her husband, Skip Richardson and three children, Danny Richardson (Kelsey), Paul Richardson (Kyle Hopkins), and Tami Jo; her precious grandson Wesley; her mother, Carol Castongia (Kenny), siblings Larry Lamie, Jim Lamie (Gretchen), Pam Weigand (Michael), Kurt Lamie, Frank "T" Lamie (Meghann), brother-and-sister in law Ernie and Kathy Richardson, brother-and-sister in law Terri and Joe Fox, and an extra-large family of nieces, nephews, cousins, and cherished friends. She is preceded in death by her father, Larry Lamie, and sisters-in-law, Donna Richardson and Pam Fisher.
