Carol M. Hoover, age 95, of Kankakee, passed away peacefully in her home on Friday, May 16, 2025.

She was born December 24, 1929 in Coon Rapids, IA, the daughter of Freeman & Ruth Nimrod Mingus.

Carol married C. Max Hoover on September 29, 1951. He preceded her in death on April 23, 1988.

She grew up in Coon Rapids, IA, where she was on the state championship basketball team in 1946 and was prom queen. After high school, she attended Commercial Business School in Omaha, NE. In 1948, she moved to Chicago, where she met and married C. Max Hoover. Max & Carol moved to Los Altos, CA in 1959, where they lived until 1962. Their final move was to Kankakee, IL, where they spent the rest of their lives.

Carol was a former Riverside Medical Center Foundation Board member. She volunteered for the American Red Cross. Carol was a lifelong member of the Kankakee Country Club.
