Charles “Chuck” M. Noble, age 86, of Manhattan, KS, formerly of Shorewood, IL, died Thursday September 3, 2015 at the Good Shepherd Hospice House in Manhattan.

He was born on August 12, 1929, in Manteno, Illinois, the son of Charles N. and Valeria (Reed) Noble. He attended schools in the area, completed his Bachelor of Science degree in engineering at the University of Illinois and then joined the United State Army and served during the Korean Conflict.

Chuck worked for the Caterpillar Tractor Company in Illinois as a design engineer for 36 years, retiring in 1991. He enjoyed gardening and genealogy and was a member of the Elks Lodge in Joliet, IL.
