He received an Associate Degree from Kankakee Community College. Herscher High School Band was a highlight of his school years. He participated in both Marching Band and Orchestra.

Chris moved to Richmond, VA in 2008, where he lived with his girlfriend, Stephanie Hill. He was very happy there and found independence, among other many things to do, while living there. He enjoyed computer work and did an online music show for the blind community. He also did Beta testing for computer games for the visually impaired.

He is survived by his parents Wendy and Greg Skarstad of Herscher. He was preceded in death by his sister Stacy Rene and his grandparents Jim and Pat Underdahl of Lincoln City, OR and Jim and Barb Skarstad of Kankakee.
