



Clarence Kenneth Ouwenga

October 10, 1918 - January 31, 2019

Clarence Kenneth Ouwenga, age 100, of Manteno, died on Thursday, January 31, 2019 at Riverside Senior Living in Bourbonnais, IL. Clarence was born on October 10, 1918 to Nicholas and Hilda (Piersma)

Ouwenga in Worth, IL. He married Emily Oosterhoff on October 9, 1943 in Momence, IL. Emily died in 2012.

Agriculture was Clarence's life. He took on the responsibility of his dad's vegetable farm at the age of

18. He took much pride in raising vegetables before retiring from farming in 1996. He and his wife Emily

were charter members of Faith Reformed Church in Kankakee where he served on the church board and

was a past elder and deacon. He was also a member and past director of the Kankakee Farm Bureau, and a past director of Farmers Elevator Co. of

Manteno. He enjoyed golfing, bowling, traveling and playing pinochle. Much of their time was also spent enjoying their children, grandchildren and their families.

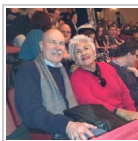
