



Darwin Leroy Jaenicke

June 22, 1931 - November 7, 2020

Darwin Leroy Jaenicke, 89, of Kankakee passed away November 7, 2020 at Amita St. Mary's Hospital. He was born June 22, 1931 in LaCrosse, WI to Witold and Norma (Spry) Jaenicke. April 1940 his family moved to Kankakee, IL and Darwin achieved membership into the National Honor Society and graduated from Kankakee High School in 1950. He then attended the University of Illinois. Darwin proudly served our country in the US Air Force from 1951 until 1955. He married JoAnn Blackmore in Kankakee December 29, 1951 and she passed away December 29, 2015.

Darwin was the owner and operator of Jaenicke's Root Beer Stand in Kankakee from 1955 to 1975 and the owner operator of D & J Motors from 1976 to 1980. He was an elected Township official for 45 years, a Trustee from 1964 to 1981, a member of Township officials of IL for 45 years and was the Kankakee Township Highway Road Commissioner from 1981 to 2009.

Darwin was always active in civic clubs; the Kankakee Jaycees, the Kankakee Lions Club, President of Kankakee Camera Club, President of Kankakee Coin Club, a lifetime member of Kankakee City Historical Society and a lifetime member of Kankakee Model Flyers. He dreamed of being a pilot and flying an airplane when he was a child and later obtained his private pilot's license in 1963 which allowed him to fly airplanes for 50 years. Darwin enjoyed Antique collecting and restoration, woodworking, reading, model building and flying radio-controlled planes. He was an avid car collector, and enjoyed traveling and photography.

Darwin is survived by his companion, Barbara Bogacz of Kankakee, a son, Dennis Jaenicke of Kankakee, 2 daughters; Barbara (James) Angel of Winter Park, FL, Linda (Eric) Boness of Kankakee, a daughter-in-law, Valerie Jaenicke of Kankakee, 3 grandchildren; Amanda Angel (Jesse) Pagan of Orlando, FL, J.B. (Kathryn) Angel of Orlando, FL, Emi Angel of Orlando, FL and 2 great grandchildren; Jameson and Eleanor. Also surviving is a brother, Alvin Jaenicke of Lompoc, CA and a sister, Ellen Wood of North Bend, NE and many nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a brother, Gordon and a son, James.

A visitation will be 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. Saturday, November 14, 2020 at Schreffler Funeral Home, Kankakee Chapel. Due to the recent Covid 19 restrictions guests will be ushered in small groups. Per CDC guidelines, masks and social distancing are required. A private memorial service will take place at a later date.
