Dennis L. "Denny" Sikes, age 73, of Clifton passed away Tuesday, January 26, 2021 at his home. He was born April 8, 1947 in Kankakee, the son of Edward & Marjorie (Goudreau) Sikes.

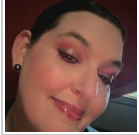
