Eloise E. Ruark, 91, of Bourbonnais passed away February 17, 2016 at The Bickford House. She was born August 5, 1924 in Kankakee to Walter and Elnora (Schmoll) Ruark. Eloise graduated from Earl Park High School in Indiana where she was the Valedictorian of her class. She continued her education at Gallagher Business College in Kankakee. Eloise was employed by New York Central Railroad from July 10, 1944 as a secretary and retired from Consolidated Rail Corp February 10, 1987. During this time she was the office manager and the first female sale representative for the railroad. Eloise enjoyed bowling, golfing and socializing with the organizations she belonged to.
