Frank A. Burke, age 88, of Kankakee, died on Thursday, June 17, 2016 at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee. Frank was born on January 26, 1928 to Harvey and Margaret (Masters) Burke in Winkle, IL. He proudly served our country in the United States Army 11th Airborne Division. He married Virginia Caby on January 21, 1950 in Cutler, IL. He was an iron worker for Local 444 in Joliet for 45 years before his retirement in 1990.
