My deepest condolences to Frieda's beloved family. She was my piano teacher at Modern Music Studios on Dearborn Avenue in downtown Kankakee from 1954-1960 when I was 11 until 17. Time has flown. Dearborn Avenue is gone now and I'm 76. She and her sisters were wonderful teachers. I was there every week all those happy years. Her sister Dora taught my younger brother guitar.

During those years Frieda had a baby (who would be around 60 today) and everyone was so excited and happy for her. Frieda instilled such a love and passion for music in my heart and I have been a professional musician all my life and my children and ten grandchildren all play instruments. My two oldest grandchildren received degrees in music and now teach. The work she did lives on in hundreds of musicians she encouraged and trained. I lived in Chicago from 1963 through 2013 and was very active with my piano.

During my years with her, she had a baby (who would be around 60 years old now) and everyone was so excited and happy for her. I remember missing her terribly when a different person was there filling in for her. Frieda would always sit quietly and listen while I played and she would have her pencil out handwriting the chords and lead sheet for my song assignment for the coming week. I treasure all that music. I still have all of those sheets and find it hard to believe it was that many years ago.

Love and music always live on. May our Lord hold her in the palm of His hand. And may God bless and comfort her loved ones during this time of loss.
