Idella M. Brooks , 85 of Chebanse passed away Saturday May 16th at Iroquois Memorial Hospital in Watseka.

A wake for Idella Marie Elizabeth (Meyer) Brooks, 85, will be held Friday, May 22, from 3 to 7 pm at the Kankakee Chapel of Schreffler Funeral Home, followed immediately by services to celebrate her life, officiated by Reverend Karl Koepen at the funeral home. Burial will take place at Kankakee Memorial Gardens Cemetery in Aroma Township following the services.

Although her illness with COPD was a long and difficult journey, she remained positive and happy, always offering a smile to and genuine concern to those who helped take care of her. She was a lifetime member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Kankakee, and an avid member of the Red Hat Society.
