James L. Beyerlein, 85 of Kankakee passed away June 5, 2016 at Riverside Medical Center. He was born September 19, 1930 in Momence to Frederick and Glenola (Butler) Beyerlein. James married the former Ann Kuhn in 1960. He was the owner of NuArt Sign Company of Bradley, which he took over from his father and mother and ran for 30 years. James was an All American Trap shooter and held a 99.9% average for 10 years straight. He was a long time member of St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church.

He is survived by 2 sons and a daughter in law; Jeff Beyerlein of Kankakee and Michael (Rachele) Beyerlein of Charlotte, MI. Also surviving are two granddaughters; Madison and Macey Beyerlein and his former wife; Ann Garry of Ft. Myers, FL. He was preceded in death by his parents.
