Dr. Janet V. Leonard, age 91, of St. Anne, passed away Monday, May 20, 2019 at Miller Healthcare Center in Kankakee.

She was born November 10, 1927 in Rushville, IN, the daughter of Herschel and Marie Benton Van Matre.

She married Charles G. Leonard on April 23, 1971 at the 4th Presbyterian Church in Chicago.

He preceded her in death December 6, 1997.

She was a member of Asbury United Methodist Church, where she served as a board of trustee and sang in the choir for over 22 years.

The Leonards had been long-term patrons of the Lyric Opera, The Chicago Symphony Orchestra and the Court, Goodman and Shakespeare Repertory Theatres in Chicago.

She was a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution and served as treasurer for 12 years. She was a member of the Kankakee Area YMCA and a member of the Board of Directors (1995-2001). In 1985, Janet served as vice president of the Minerva Club. She also belonged to the Travelers and the Woman's Club of Kankakee. She was a board member of the Kankakee Valley Symphony Orchestra. Janet belonged to the Kankakee Country Club. For ten years, she served as a board of director for the Kankakee County Historical Society. She also served on the board of directors for the Northeastern Illinois Area Agency on Aging.

There will be no visitation or services. Cremation rites will be accorded.

Inurnment will be held at Miller Cemetery in Middletown, IN.

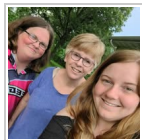
