



## Joel P. Gereaux

Joel P. Gereaux, 90, of Bradley, Illinois, peacefully passed away on Saturday, May 2, 2026, surrounded by his loving family.

Joel was born on March 13, 1936, in Watseka, Illinois, the son of Leonard and Alice (Sandquist) Gereaux. Joel was the last of six children. He graduated from Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School in 1954. On August 31, 1957, Joel married Carol Swinford and they were the proud parents of four children.

Joel was a homebuilder and remodeled homes around the community. He was a former trustee for the Village of Bradley, the president of the Bradley Public Library Board, and a former longtime member of The Hundred Club. Joel was also a member of Bradley Evangelical United Methodist Church, where he served on the administrative council. He was a longtime Chicago White Sox and Bears fan and enjoyed Nascar and southern gospel music.
