Julian Brantson Mitten, 66, was welcomed into his heavenly home November 23, 2022. A native of Bourbonnais, Mitten attended area schools and participated in the 1977 graduation from Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School. He worked at Kankakee County Training Center.

An avid swimmer and dancer, Mitten has participated in the Special Olympics, served as guest presenter in a class on Human Diversity at Olivet Nazarene University, and been introduced on the floor of the Missouri State Legislature.

Mitten was preceded in death by his parents, Lloyd and Thelma Mitten. He is survived by three brothers and a sister: Don (Mary) Mitten of Galva, Illinois, Mary (Tim) Mercer of Bourbonnais, Peter Mitten (Kathy Wehe) of Hemet, California, and Bruce (Karen) Mitten of Madison, Wisconsin, seven nephews and four nieces, several great nieces and nephews, one uncle and aunt, nine cousins, and a host of friends.
