Kevin Graveline, 61, of Bourbonnais passed away on Saturday, December 22, 2018 at his home. He was born on November 18, 1957, the son of Adrian and MaryAnn (Hupel) Graveline. Kevin married Linda Sederstrand of May 22, 1982.

Kevin was a graduate of Bishop McNamara Catholic High School and was a member of St. George Catholic Church. He coached BB Little League baseball and Dynamo Soccer and was a Cub Scout Leader and Cub Master for Pack 324 when his boys were involved in these activities. Kevin was a painter for Graveline Decorating and later worked for Coca-Cola as a route salesman – where he was top route salesman 3 years in a row. Kevin was an avid sports fan, fisherman, camper and gardener. He sold vegetables in front of his home for ten years.
