“ I am so sorry to hear of the passing of our sweet Aunt Jo.

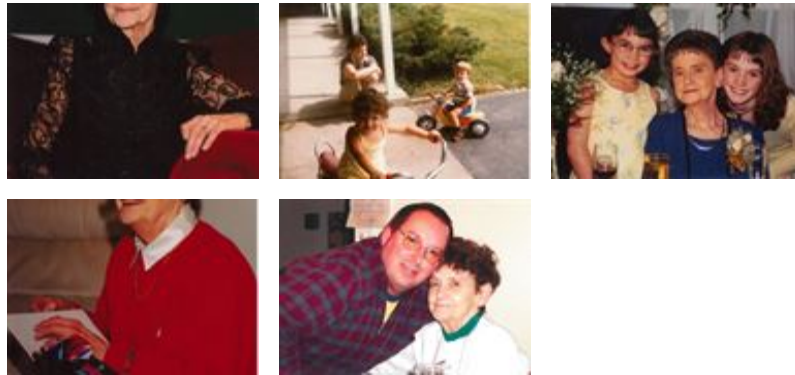
