Marguerite D. Schuh, age 96, of Bourbonnais, passed away Friday, September 8, 2017 at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee.

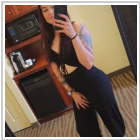

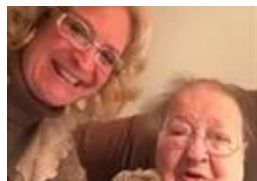
