Paul A. Boudreau, 96, of Bourbonnais passed away on Friday, March 29, 2019 at Heritage Village in Kankakee. He was born on November 21, 1922 in Kankakee, the son of Harvey and Lucille (Muehler) Boudreau. Paul married Dolores Cyrier on May 22, 1943. She preceded him in death on August 18, 2008.

Paul was a Model Maker for David Bradley Manufacturing for 42 years, until his retirement in 1984. He was a member of Maternity BVM Catholic Church in Bourbonnais and the David Bradley Keyman's Club.

Paul enjoyed gardening, watching sports and was a lifelong fan of the Chicago White Sox.
