Randal Lyle Bisailon, age 76 of Herscher, passed away Thursday, September 12, 2024 at Prairieview Lutheran Home in Danforth. He was born October 3, 1947 in Kankakee, the son of Leo and Opal Horn Bisailon. Randy married Linda Nowack on May 28, 1967. She survives.

Randy was the owner and operator of Bisailon Excavating Inc. for over 40 years. He also was a lifelong farmer. Some of Randy's construction highlights include Park Place Subdivision, High Point Estates & Golf Course, Kmart Distribution Center, and numerous buildings and subdivisions throughout Kankakee, Will, and Iroquois counties.

Randy was a great entrepreneur, owning a range of different businesses from a stone quarry to a golf course to an ice cream shop to subdivisions and more.

Randy was an Army Veteran of Vietnam serving from 1967 to 1969. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Herscher.

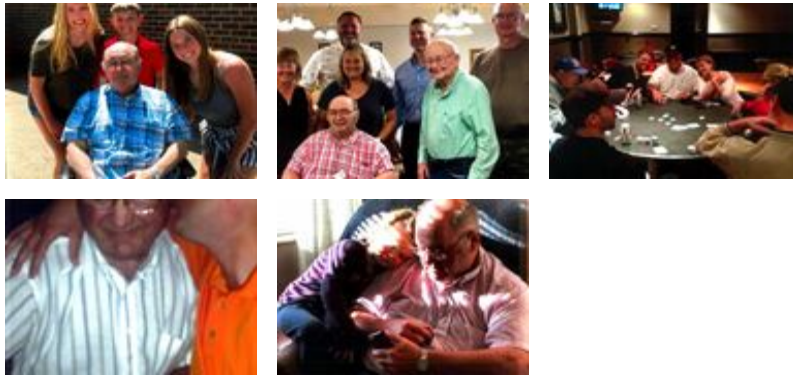
