



## Rev. Dr. William W. "Bill" Dean

February 15, 1947 - May 16, 2024

Rev. Dr. William W. "Bill" Dean age 77 of Bourbonnais, passed away Thursday, May 16, 2024, at his home. He was born February 15, 1947, in Salem, Virginia, the son of E.W. and Dorothy (Mills) Dean. Bill married Joan Whitby on June 5, 1970, at Evangelical Methodist Church in Friendship, TN. Bill was a professor and a pastor. He devoted his life to the Lord and to his family. Bill wrote that he was "A teacher by trade and a pastor by calling." He was a scholar, and invested his knowledge and time into those around him. He loved spending time outside and had a love for gardening.

Bill was a member of the Zoar Community Church, Reddick, IL.
