Robert J. Messier, age 88, a lifelong resident of Kankakee, passed away on Friday, January 2, 2026 at his residence surrounded by his loving family. Bob was born on December 9, 1937, in Kankakee, a son of Emile and Josephine (Ignacowitz) Messier. He married Mary Lou White on May 9, 1964, at St. Joseph Catholic Church, Bradley.

Bob was a Sheet Metal Worker for Local 243, working for 30 years before his retirement. He has been a member of Local 243 for 60 years. He was on the Limestone Park Board and served as President for many years. Bob was also a member of the Kankakee Hundred Club, Ducks Unlimited and the Delta Waterfowl. He enjoyed hunting and fishing as well as woodworking, collecting many trinkets and was always tinkering in his garage on his various projects.

A Veteran of the United States Coast Guard, Bob served from 1956 until 1960 and was deployed to Vietnam during that time. He was on the first icebreaker, the U.S.S. Evergreen, that went through the Northwest Passage.

Survivors include his wife of 61 years, Mary Lou, of Kankakee; three sons, Val (Beth) Messier of Limestone, Bryan (Lisa) Messier of Bradley, and Allen (Donna) Messier of Limestone; five grandchildren, Nicholas Messier, Samantha (Tyler) Werner, John (Hannah) Raimondo, Cara (John) Becker and Jenna Soucie; and six great-grandchildren.

Bob was preceded in death by his parents and his only brother, David (Yvonne) Messier.

Cremation rites have been accorded and a Memorial Service with military honors will be held on Friday, January 9, 2026 at 3:30pm at Schreffler Funeral Home, Kankakee with Deacon Patrick Skelly officiating. 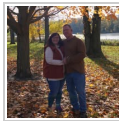

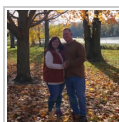

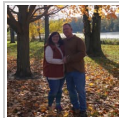
