



Stephen R. Alvey

May 27, 1947 - October 31, 2023

Stephen R. Alvey, 76, passed away of natural causes on Tuesday, October 31st, 2023 while serving as security for Grace Christian Academy in Kankakee, Illinois.

Steve was born in Kankakee, IL to Milton “Jim” and Mary Alvey (Gilbert) on May 27th 1947. He graduated from Momence Community Unit High School in 1965. Steve honorably served in the United States Marine Corps from 1966 to 1967.

Upon his discharge from the Marine Corps, Steve returned home and worked at Carter Wallace in Momence and Riverside Hospital. He joined the Auxiliary Police, and in 1970 was hired as a Bradley Police Officer. While on patrol February 11th 1972, Steve entered a burning residence to rescue a Bradley man who had been trapped inside. He was promoted to Sergeant in 1980 where he served as the midnight shift supervisor for many years. He was one of the department's first Evidence Technicians, handled many cases, including an integral part of the team that investigated the Tara Sue Huffman murder case in 1981. Steve was founder and director of the Kankakee Valley

Emergency Youth Corps., a Police and Fire Cadet program sponsored by the Village of Bradley from 1972-1978. Many area youth who were members, went on to be career Police Officers and Firefighters, with some becoming Chiefs and Command Officers. This program was highly supported by the community and recognized by State Officials, and Steve volunteered many hours to its success.

He retired as a Police Officer in 1996 due to an on-duty injury and again served the department as a Dispatcher/Telecommunicator for the next twelve years. Upon retirement and until his death, he served as security at Grace Christian Academy where he was known as "Mr. Alvey or Steve", and took pride in protecting and helping out at the school.

He was a member of Grace Baptist Church-Kankakee, Exline Sportsmans Club and former member of the Kankakee Camera Club. He enjoyed attending church, local sporting events, and spending time with his relatives and close friends.

Steve is preceded in death by his parents, and his younger brothers, James and Keith Alvey.

Steve is survived by his sisters Sue (Ralph) Donnelly, Donna (Roger) Anderson, Kathy Alvey, and Joy Alvey; nephews Rick Donnelly, Joshua Alvey,

Jared (Wendy) Alvey, and Kyle Alvey; nieces Debbra (Dave) Petke, Barb (Dale) Howard, Trinity (Greg) Maston, Kristin (Thomas) McGinnis; extended family Steve (Dena) Coy, Meagan Coy, Heather Coy, Riley, Jace and Jack Havener, Brandon (Kyra) Stokes, and Marita Stokes.

He is fondly remembered for his friendliness, generosity, and service to others.

Cremation rites have been accorded. A memorial visitation will be held from 4:00 p.m. until the 6:00 p.m. memorial service on Monday, November 6, 2023 at Grace Baptist Church. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to Grace Baptist Church.

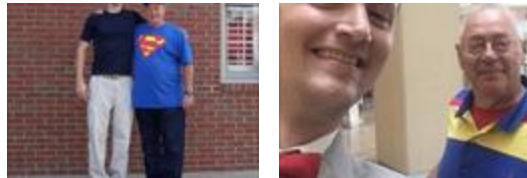
