Thomas J. Kearney, 62, of Kankakee passed away on Thursday, September 8, 2016 at Riverside Medical Center. He was born on November 28, 1953 in Elmhurst, the son of Floyd and Lorraine (Powalisz) Kearney. Tom married Susan Kloth, who survives in Kankakee.

Tom was known as “Papa Science” and “Coach Kearney” to many children in the area. He taught Science, Biology and Animal Behavior at Stagg High School in Palos Hills and Andrew High School in Tinley Park; also substitute teaching at Kankakee Junior High. Along with teaching, Tom worked to implement recycling in schools, coached Track, Football, Little League, participated in 4H, was a Cub Scout Leader, member of the Kankakee Park District and many other activities. “Earth Stewards” was a non-profit organization that Tom started to create hands on science education in schools. He was the published author of two books, which were published in a Mathematical Professional Journal. Tom was a Teacher Advisor at Brookfield Zoo. His most recent project was being a Science Consultant for Mosamack, which made educational videos for science classrooms.

Being an Alumni and Big Ten Letterman at the University of Illinois, Tom was a season ticket holder and part of the Legacy Lounge. He enjoyed attending Fighting Illini games and being a “Beach Papa”.

Tom wore many hats, but mostly his Fighting Illini one.

He is survived by his wife, Susan Kearney of Kankakee; two sons Adam (Patricia) Kearney of Midlothian and Kevin (Amy) Kearney of St. Anne; one daughter Julie (Joe) Glogowski of St. Anne; one sister Kathleen Blazek of Streamwood; two brothers William (Debi) Kearney of Michigan and Michael (Susan) Kearney of St. Louis; and eight grandchildren Alyssa, Noah, Alanna, Emily, Kylie, Camden, Chloe and Colten. He was preceded in death by his parents and two nephews Christopher Blazek and Sean Blazek.

Visitation will be held on Monday, September 12, 2016 from 2pm-8pm at Schreffler Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. Funeral service will be on Tuesday, September 13, 2016 at 12pm, with additional visitation starting at 9am, at the funeral home. Rev. Jeff Horch will officiate the service.
