Trudy Capelle, age 68, of Kankakee, passed away on May 24, 2015 at home. Trudy was born on April 10, 1947 to Harold and Dixie (Kennedy) Capelle, Jr. in Kankakee. Ms. Capelle began her teaching career in 1971 at Herscher schools and Momence. After teaching in Southern Illinois, she continued her work in Special Education with District 111 (1979 - 2006). After retiring from KSD she continued to teach preschool for special needs children part time in Momence and Pembroke School districts. She received her Bachelor's degree from Northern Illinois University and did her graduated work in Special Education at Southern Illinois University. She was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Herscher teaching Sunday school for many years. Ms. Capelle was very active in the Kankakee School District Teachers Union serving as Vice President and President for nearly 25 years. In the 1980's she served as house chairman for the Junior League of Kankakee County, helping to restore the historic Stone Barn.

Trudy is survived by her daughter, Tara (Michael) Kanoski of Bradley, IL and two grandchildren, Cameron and Chase Kanoski. She was preceded in death by her parents.

Visitation will take place on June 15, 2015 from 12:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. at Schreffler Funeral Home's Kankakee Chapel. Trudy's funeral service will immediately follow visitation time and begin at 4:00 p.m. Pastor Eric Brown will officiate. Burial will immediately follow at Trinity Lutheran Cemetery in Herscher. Cremation rites have been accorded.
