



Virginia "Ginny" Fegan

September 22, 1922 - October 19, 2017

Virginia "Ginny" Fegan, 95, of Sacramento, California (formerly of Kankakee, Illinois) passed away peacefully on October 19, 2017. She can now walk and talk freely and be reunited with her beloved husband.

Ginny was born on Sept 15, 1922 in Crawford County Illinois, the middle child of Ray and Clara Williamson. She was a graduate of Hutsonville High School . She graduated from Michael Reese School of Nursing, Chicago, Illinois in 1946, she was president of her class. While in nursing school, she made life-long friends with Iva June Accola and Beatrice Fegan Lancaster. These two women had significant impacts on her life. Beady introduced her to her brother, Jack, whom she married April 17, 1948. Iva helped Virginia and Jack adopt Mary Frances in 1956. Virginia was head nurse at Michael Reese until 1948 she and Jack moved to Kankakee. She continued working at St. Mary's Hospital for two years and then for Drs. Horowitz, Iler and Milder. She was an active member of Asbury United Methodist Church. She enjoyed living in Gracefield, playing bridge, golfing, reading, entertaining, Florida vacations and dinners out with Jack.

In 1969 (she was 46), Virginia's life changed drastically, due to a brain Aneurysm that resulted in Cerebrovascular Accident (CVA). Due to her determination and strength and spirit, after months/years of rehabilitation, she was able to speak and walk again. She did not let her disability slow her down or taint her spirits. She set an example and touched the lives of all who knew her. She came to Sacramento in 2002 and lived with Mary and her family until

April 2017, when she moved to Marconi Villa, as her body was failing her. Virginia is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Mary and Brad Stockert ; the joys in her life, grandchildren Rebecca Carrig and John Stockert and great-grandchildren Paisley and Bodhi Carrig. She is also survived by her sisters- in-law Bernetta Williamson and Beatrice Lancaster; also many nieces and nephews that brought laughter and happiness.

She was preceded in death by her husband, John Fegan, her parents, sisters and brother in laws; Mary Elizabeth & Claude, Frances & Pope, brothers and sister in law; Glen & Ellen, and Marion.

Visitation will held on Saturday, October 28, 2017 from 10am until the 11am funeral service at Schreffler Funeral Home in Kankakee. Burial will follow at Mound Grove Gardens of Memory in Kankakee. 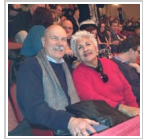

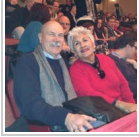
